Overview:

Lile has been involved with Valley Medical Center since 2004 and has evolved into a leading logistics solutions provider. The VMC facility is approximately 300,000 sq ft. which includes a complete Level III Trauma Center, Hospital, 12 regional clinics, and medical offices. On a daily basis, Lile's Project Leader works on-site with VMC teams to consult on all phases of relocation planning with VMC construction teams, and is the primary "go to person" with departments to ensure planning and relocation operations are stress free to patients, primary caregivers, and physicians with VMC mission in mind.

Project Management has included relocations for a variety of internal departments such as:

- Complete relocation of Hospital Pharmacy. Participation included process planning and strategy meetings with Facilities Management, Construction Contractors, and Department Heads to ensure VMC day-to-day relocation activities would not affect patient care during the construction process.
- Roll out of new 50,000 sq. ft. Surgery Center. Activities included fulfillment and delivery of medical equipment, transport and assembly of a variety of surgery equipment such as surgery room lighting, medical equipment, furniture, construction materials, and complete relocation of Surgery Center into new space. Lile coordinated the transition to allow the hospital to remain operational during the transition.
- Pre-Planned space reconfiguration with departments to allow VMC to baseline the design and construction process. Project responsibilities also included complete coordination of patient wings with facilities, Gift Shops, Admissions redesign, Finance, Eye Clinic, Materials, and VMC logistics.
- Lile also supported removal and disposition of surplus equipment and furniture.

Lile is actively involved in strategy meetings with transition teams, staff, and department heads. Through our Project Management services, we are able to coordinate all activity within VMC mission and fiscal guidelines to ensure a seamless stress-free transition for patients, their families, and caregivers during every project.
